CAPTAIN BUB'S BASS TRAIL - 2023 - RULES

- The maximum number of boats for these tournaments will be twenty four.
- 2. Individual registrations will be accepted at the ramp but only cash.
- 3. The tournaments can be fished as a team (2) or as an individual.
- 4. Any boat involved with these tournaments must be covered with a minimum of \$300,000 of liability insurance. By entering these tournaments and your signature below you acknowledge that you have the required insurance and waive all liability claims against tournament officials and all associated parties.
- 5. Safety each contestant is required to wear a personal flotation device (PFD) anytime the combustion engine is running and a functional kill ignition switch must be attached to the PFD. All state boating and fish and game laws apply to the tournaments.
- 6. These tournaments will be a five fish limit and only smallmouth or largemouth bass will be weighed. The minimum length will be 12"
- 7. Only artificial lures can be used and trolling as a method of fishing will not be allowed.
- 8. Off limits for tournament waters will be 6:00 PM the night before the scheduled tournament (except TOC). Off limits during the tournament will be given out at the pre-tournament meeting.
- Protests must be made in writing and presented to the tournament directors prior to the last boat weighed in.

- 10. Tournament scores will be based on the total weight of the bass caught be each boat. Boats weighing in more than the tournament limit (5) will be disqualified. Bass that are weighed in that are dead will result in an 8 oz. penalty. Bass that are presented for weighing that are short (less than 12") will result in a penalty of 1 lb. plus the loss of the short fish. A courtesy check can be made with the official ruler.
- 11. Late Penalty start and stop times will be announced at the pre-tournament meeting. Any boat that does not check in at the required time will be penalized one pound for each minute or portion thereof for up to 10 minutes. Any boat more than 10 minutes late will be disqualified.
- 12. Any boat that breaks down during the tournament will be allowed to transfer their catch to another tournament boat. The fish must be marked clearly and separated by the anglers for the weigh in.
- 13. Official scales will be supplied by the tournament directors, in case of a scale malfunction a hand held digital scale will be substituted for the weigh in.
- 14. Ties if a tie exists after the weigh in the following steps will be used to determine the winner: (1) most fish,(2) largest fish and (3) coin toss.
